HERE'S THE NEW DROP-OFF PLAN CAMP AIRY

DROP-OFF TIMES

(Both Camps)
8:00-10:30 am
for all dates except 7/10
(1:00-3:00 pm)

STATION 1 LUGGAGE DROP-OFF AND PARKING

Drive into Camp Airy where you will be directed to the parking area. Staff will assist you with your luggage (2 pieces maximum, please).

STATION 2 REGISTRATION

Head to the gym to check in, complete any forms, sign up for trips, and to leave spending money.

STATION 3 PERSONAL MEDICAL

If your son takes medication, proceed to the Medication area. If not, head to Station 4 to meet with the Health Center staff.

STATION 4 HEALTH CENTER

Complete your son's medical registration. Our doctors and nurses will perform a brief health screening of each camper. This will include processing his medical forms and a temperature and lice check. Once your son is cleared by the Health Center staff, it is time to head uphill to his bunk!

STATION 5 MEET THE COUNSELORS

Meet your son's counselors and Unit Leader. Wish him a great summer and say goodbye!

CAMP LOUISE

STATION 1 LUGGAGE DROP-OFF

Drive to the gravel area across from camp's main gate, where you'll learn your daughter's bunk number and drop off her luggage. Please plan to drop off a maximum of 2 pieces of luggage.

STATION 2 PARKING AND REGISTRATION

Drive about 1 block to Ft. Ritchie and park in the designated area. Complete check-in (including all forms and permission slips), sign up for trips and deposit money in the camp bank. Then head to the Ft. Ritchie bus stop to board the bus up to Camp Louise.

Parking and registration for Louise 2 Short and Rookie Session 2 will be adjacent to the Luggage Drop-Off Area.

STATION 3 PERSONAL MEDICAL

If your daughter takes medication, proceed to the White House to begin the medical check-in process. If not, proceed to Station 4.

STATION 4 HEALTH CENTER

Complete your daughter's medical registration in the Health Center. Our doctors and nurses will perform a brief health screening of each camper. We'll process her medical forms and do a temperature and lice check. Once your daughter is cleared by the Health Center staff, it's time to head up the hill to her bunk!

STATION 5 MEET THE COUNSELORS

Meet your daughter's counselors and Unit Leader. Wish her a great summer, say goodbye and board the bus back to Ft. Ritchie.
