



NOTICE TO PARENTS AND STAFF MEMBERS: Camp Airy is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged personal belongings. Please make sure you are covered against fire, loss and theft in your insurance policy. If the value of baggage exceeds coverage, take out additional insurance for the duration of your son's stay at camp.

IMPORTANT: All belongings and articles of clothing are to be marked carefully with your son's full name. Printed name tapes should be attached, or the name marked with indelible ink. Tennis racquet, shoes, camping equipment, cameras, eyeglass cases and luggage should be marked also. All items of clothing should be sent in sufficient amounts to ensure cleanliness, neatness and appropriateness for differing weather conditions. No gum, electric fans, scooters, pocket knives, TV's, VCR's, cellular phones or expensive electronic games are allowed.
