Suggested Staff Packing List

Notice to staff members: Camp Airy is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged personal belongings. Please make sure you are covered against fire, loss and theft in your insurance policy. If the value of the baggage exceeds coverage, take out additional insurance for the duration of your stay at camp.

It is a really good idea to write your name on everything that you bring to camp, including your clothing, water bottles, electronics, etc. You're living in a shared space and things can be lost in your bunk or while you're out and about at camp. If your name is on your belongings, they can be more easily returned to you when/if someone picks them up. You can get labels made or use a sharpie to put your name on important items.

For International Staff: You can request that linens be provided to you upon your arrival at camp. There will also be a chance to purchase toiletry items in America within 24 hours of your arrival.
